6. Was there a moment when you realized the story was about more than saving the foundation?
7. Which scene was your favorite?
8. Was there a moment that surprised you?
9. Did the ending leave you satisfied? Why or why not?
10. If you could ask one character a question, who would it be and what would you ask?
11. After finishing the novel, what does Naomi's legacy mean to you? Did your understanding of the title change as you read?
